

Instructional Objectives
Floor Hockey (Grade 6)

P1

The student will perform stick handling using TA form to control a puck while running the length of a basketball court 3 out of 5 times.

P2

The student will pass a hockey puck using TA form to a stationary target (classmate) 20 feet away 2 of 3 times.

P3

The student will pass a hockey puck using TA form to a moving target (classmate) 20 feet away 2 of 3 times.

P4

The student will pass a hockey puck using TA form to a moving target (classmate) 20 feet away while being defended 2 of 3 times.

P5

The student will shoot a hockey puck using TA form while being stationary to a target 10 feet away 2 of 3 times.

P6

The student will shoot a hockey puck using TA form while moving at a target 10 feet away 2 of 3 times.

P7

The student will perform goalkeeping using TA form while stopping 2 of 3 pucks shot at the net from 15 feet away.

P8

The student will perform stick handling using TA form to control a puck while moving through a series of 6 cones in a weaving motion 2 of 3 times.

P9

The student will perform goalkeeping using TA form while stopping 2 of 3 pucks shot at the net from 10 feet by using the goal keeper glove.

P10

The student will perform defensive duties against offensive players by stopping 2 of 3 offensive pass attempts without making physical contact with offensive players.

P11

The student will perform defensive duties against offensive players by stopping 2 of 3 shots attempted on goal without making physical contact with offensive player.

C1

The student will demonstrate the capacity to apply information demonstrated by the instructor of stick handling using TA form while running the length of a basketball court.

C2

The student will demonstrate the capacity to apply information demonstrated by the instructor of passing a hockey puck using TA form to a stationary target (classmate) 20 feet away 2 of 3 times.

C3

The student will demonstrate the capacity to apply information demonstrated by the instructor of passing a hockey puck using TA form to a moving target (classmate) 20 feet away 2 of 3 times.

C4

The student will demonstrate the capacity to apply information demonstrated by the instructor of passing a hockey puck using TA form to a moving target (classmate) while being defended 2 of 3 times.

C5

The student will demonstrate the capacity to apply information demonstrated by the instructor of shooting a hockey puck using TA form while being stationary to a target 10 feet away 2 of 3 times.

C6

The student will demonstrate the capacity to apply information demonstrated by the instructor of shooting a hockey puck using TA form while moving at a target 10 feet away 2 of 3 times.

C7

The student will demonstrate the capacity to apply information demonstrated by the instructor of goalkeeping using TA form while stopping 2 of 3 pucks shot at a net from 15 feet away.

C8

The student will demonstrate the capacity to apply knowledge of the history and rules of floor hockey on a written test by answering at least 70% of the questions correctly.

PS1

The student will demonstrate responsibility by wearing proper PE dress in 14 of 15 days.

PS2

The student will demonstrate responsibility by performing tasks assigned by the instructor 15/15 days.

The student will demonstrate cooperation by working with a peer or team to accomplish assigned floor hockey skill or activity.
