

Instructional Objectives for Seventh Grade Softball

PSYCHOMOTOR

1. Students will perform the proper overhand throw, according to TA form, by throwing the ball to a 3ft by 3ft target on the wall 30 feet away, 4/5 times.
2. Students will perform the proper overhand throw, according to TA form, by throwing the ball to a partner 30 feet away, 4/5 times.
3. Students will demonstrate proper batting, according to TA form, to hit a ball off a tee 4/5 times.
4. Students will demonstrate proper batting, according to TA form, by hitting a pitched ball from 30 feet away 4/5 times.
5. Students will perform catching, according to TA form, a thrown ball from a partner 30 feet away 4/5 times.

COGNITIVE

1. 3 out of 4 students will identify 1 of the critical points of the overhand throw when randomly called upon by the teacher.
2. 3 out of 4 students will identify 1 of the critical points of batting when randomly called upon by the teacher.
3. 3 out of 4 students will identify 1 of the critical points of catching the ball when randomly called upon by the teacher.
4. When randomly called upon, 2 out of 3 students will verbally identify softball rules for the activity they will do as described by the instructor.

PERSONAL-SOCIAL

1. The students will demonstrate responsibility by bringing proper footwear and equipment to class 95% of the time.
2. Students will demonstrate respect for authority by following directions given by the teacher 95% of the time.
3. Students will demonstrate respect for others and equipment by sharing equipment and cooperating with teammates 95% of the time.
