

9th Grade Objectives:

Psychomotor 1: Students will perform a shot (TA Form) from a distance of 20 yards, hitting a 3' circular target with their arrows on three out of five tries.

Psychomotor 2: Students will perform a shot (TA Form) into a 20' circular target from a distance of 70 yards three out of five times.

Psychomotor 3: Five out of five students will correctly list the four critical points to retrieving an arrow (TA Form) when called upon to do so in class.

Cognitive 1: Four out of five students will correctly identify arrow patterns on a worksheet and list potential causes for the patterns.

Cognitive 2: Students will correctly score 4 out of 5 marked targets on a worksheet given in class.

Personal/Social 1: All students will demonstrate responsibility by following instructions and verbal shooting cues given by the instructor before and during each shot they take.

Personal/Social 2: Students will demonstrate cooperation with each other by sharing equipment and by giving constructive feedback to their partners on technique and form during the partner critique activities.
